A different view on heritage education is a five day training course on heritage education aiming at both **teachers (secondary and adult education) and educational guides or officers** from all over Europe.

The course is an introduction to experience based learning concerning heritage, with a focus on the arts. Art based methods are used to explore and investigate different types of heritage. This investigation leads to an artistic outcome.
